This Court, whose order dated 9.11.2002 and 30.11.2002

has appointed three Member Committees for Mumbai City Eastern Suburbs and Western Suburbs, each for considering the suggestions and objections invited from the public for finalization of parking and non-parking zones, the required expenditure for the functioning of these Committees is borne by the Municipal Corporation. In accordance to our order dated 30.11.2002, the Corporation has already spent an amount of Rs.60,00,000/- towards the construction of the Committee, their mobility, travel and other expenses etc. There apart, the Corporation has also provided to the said Committees

offices premises, clock, alarm/light, oven, Landline Telephone, computer etc for which separate expenditure has been incurred by the Corporation. There is no dispute that delimitation of Hawking and Non-Hawking Zones has already been done. This Court vide its Order dated 12.2.2007 directed the State Government to formulate the Scheme for hawkers based on National Urban Hukers Policy which is stated to have been formulated by the State Government. In such view of the matter, no judicial purpose will be served by continuing with the Three Member Committees constituted by earlier orders of this Court.

In the circumstances, no order for the dissolution of the three Member Committees forthwith subject to the following:

1. Upon dissolution of the Committee the function of the Committee with regard to deciding applications in respect of designating zones/zests as hawking zones/non-hawking zones will not be assigned to any authority.
2. The Municipality Corporation accepts the suggestion of CII space and agrees with the directions given in para 14(1) of the judgment dated 9.12.2003 to be implemented by the following:-

"Complaints in respect of hawkers, encroachers and unauthorised parkings by shop owners shall be brought to the notice of the concerned ward officer who is an Assistant Municipal Commissioner (AMC). The Ward Officer concerned shall take immediate steps to respond to the complaint and remove the hawkers, encroachers and unauthorised parkings by shop owners where he /it turns to be in a non-hawking zone/zest. In case the ward Officer takes no action, a written complaint may be filed by the citizen to his immediate superior, the Deputy Municipal Commissioner (DMC) of the zone. The DMC shall look into the complaint and if found correct will with the help of the police remove the hawkers, encroachers and unauthorised parkings by shop owners. The Headman-in-Charge of the police station concerned is directed to give prompt and immediate assistance

to the DCC. In the event of the DCC finding the conduct to be contrary, he shall be removed. An adverse remark in respect of the failure of the Ward Officer to perform his duty will be entered in the confidential Report on the Ward Officer concerned. If more than 3 such entries are found in the record of an officer, it would be a ground for terminating his probation. If more than 6 such entries are found in the record of an officer, it shall be a ground for termination of services."

3. The Municipal Corporation agrees that the functions of issuing licences to hawkers as contemplated in the Order dated 9.12.2009 and with the judgement dated 12.2.2007 will be discharged by a Senior Officer of the Municipal Corporation to be designated by the Municipal Commissioner.

4. This arrangement shall be in force until the MCM's Hawkers (Regulation of activity) Bye Law 2009 comes into force. Thereby in accordance with the order dated 12.2.2007 these directions will cease to exist. There shall be an order accordingly.
